VFD or Rx Product?

A Veterinary Feed Directive (VFD or 'VFD Order') is a written statement, provided by a licensed veterinarian, authorizing the use of a VFD drug or combination VFD drug in or on animal feed. It approves the clientto obtain, and use, the drug according to the written VFD and is conditionally approved by the FDA; it is valid for no more than 6 months. - All medically important water-soluble antibiotics require a prescription
- All medically important feed additives require a VFD

Important Notes Regarding These Guidelines:

- Extra-label use of VFD feed, or any other medicated feed, is not permitted
- When adding Neo-Terramycin to pasteurized/whole milk, it requires a prescription
- When adding Neo-Terramycin to milk replacer it requires a VFD
- Antibiotic waste milk is not viewed as a needing a VFD
